

1Thess4v1-8

1Th 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us *how you ought to walk and to please God*;

1Th 4:2 for you know what commandments we gave you through the Lord Jesus.

1Th 4:3 *For this is the will of God, your sanctification*: that you should abstain from sexual immorality;

1Th 4:4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,

1Th 4:5 not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God;

1Th 4:6 that no one should take advantage of and defraud his brother in this matter, because the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also forewarned you and testified.

1Th 4:7 For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

1Th 4:8 Therefore he who rejects this does not reject man, but God, who has also given us His Holy Spirit.

Gen1v26-28 Then God said, "Let Us make man in **Our image**, according to **Our likeness**; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

v27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

v28 Then God **blessed**(1) them, and God said to them, "Be **fruitful**(2) and **multiply**(3) ; **fill**(4) (**replenish**) the earth and **subdue it**(5); have **dominion**(6) over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."
(all that's on this earth)

1. Blessed = Happy; prosperous in worldly affairs; enjoying spiritual happiness and the favor of God;
2. Fruitful = Very productive; producing fruit in abundance; as fruitful soil; a fruitful tree; a fruitful season. Plenteous; abounding in any thing. Producing in abundance;
3. Multiply = to grow to increase, and spread
4. Replenish = to be full of!
5. Subdue = To conquer by force or the exertion of superior power; To overcome by persuasion or other mild means; To overcome; to overpower and destroy the force of; as medicines subdue a fever
6. Dominion = Sovereign or supreme authority; the power of governing and controlling.

Luke2v40 And the **Child grew** and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him.

Luk 2:43 **the Boy** Jesus

Luk 2:v49And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?"

2v51& 52 Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and **was subject to them**, (Governors and teachers) but His mother kept all these things in her heart. v52 **And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.**

Act 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

1Cor15v45 And so it is written, "THE FIRST MAN ADAM BECAME A LIVING BEING." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

We are called by the Lord to be Life Givers in these days of hopelessness and despair but you can only give out of the life your living.

I CAN ONLY BE A LIFE GIVER
IF IM LIVING THE LIFE

Isa 61:1 "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

Isa 61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn,

Isa 61:3 To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; **That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified."**

Isa 61:4 And they shall rebuild the old ruins, They shall raise up the former desolations, And they shall repair the ruined cities, The desolations of many generations.

Isa 61:5 Strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, And the sons of the foreigner Shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.

Isa 61:6 But you shall be named the priests of the LORD, They shall call you the servants of our God. You shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, And in their glory you shall boast.

THEY SHALL REBUILD - THEY SHALL RAISE UP - THEY SHALL REPAIR

Isa 61:7 **Instead of your shame you shall have double honor**, And instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; Everlasting joy shall be theirs.

Isa 61:8 "For I, the LORD, **love justice**; I hate robbery for burnt offering; I will direct their work **in truth**, And will make with them an everlasting covenant.

Isa 61:9 **Their descendants shall be known among the Gentiles, And their offspring among the people. All who see them shall acknowledge them, That they are the posterity whom the LORD has blessed."**

Psa 1:1 Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

Psa 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.

Psa 1:3 He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

Psa 1:4 The ungodly are not so, But are like the chaff which the wind drives away.

Psa 1:5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

Psa 1:6 For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Eze 47:12

Along the bank of the river, on this side and that, will grow all kinds of trees used for food; their leaves will not wither, and their fruit will not fail. They will bear fruit every month, **because their water flows from the sanctuary (THEY'VE TAPPED INTO A DIFFERENT SOURCE –HOLY SPIRIT).**
Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for medicine."

2Cor3v17&18 READ****

v17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

v18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord,
are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

But what am I beholding? What Image Do I see? – if I allow the work of sanctification of the Spirit in my life I'll drink from another source – a tree of righteousness planted by the Lord who bears fruit in season out of season whose fruit will not fail and be food to many whose leaves will not wither from the heat of the day and whose leaves are a medicine to the sick –

-1KGS 7 MOLTEN SEA, MAYHIM CHAYHIM (living waters) preists had to wash there
hands and feet prior to sering in the house;

Jesus said in Jn 13 those who have been washed only need to wash their feet –
wash the dust from there walk A WALK THAT PLEASES AND HONOURS HIM
