**REVIVAL - RECONCILIATION - REJUVENATION -

Luk 13:6 –9 He also spoke this parable: "A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. :7 Then he said to the keeper of his vineyard, 'Look, for three years I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree and find none. Cut it down; why does it use up the ground?' :8 But he answered and said to him, 'Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and (dung) fertilize it. :9 And if it bears fruit, well. But if not, after that you can cut it down.' "

The owner of the vineyard planted the tree in the soil
The tree never chose the ground - the owner did.
